THROUGH THE YEARS

- July 1, 1998 – Merger of IAM Districts 148 and 721 into DL 140 by GVP Dave Ritchie
- October 1998 – Vancouver Airport Security Screeners join IAM DL 140
- August 24, 1999 – ONEX Corporation attempts hostile takeover of Air Canada and Canadian Airlines
- January 1, 2001 – Air Canada completes merger with Canadian Airlines International
- December 4, 2003 – Air Canada files for bankruptcy under CCAA
- September 30, 2004 – Air Canada emerges from CCAA
- April 2006 – Air Transat workers join IAM DL 140
- May 2006 – Vancouver Swissport workers join DL 140
- September 23, 2008 – Air Canada Technical Services becomes Aveos Fleet Performance
- March 2009 – Wasaya Air ground crew workers join IAM DL 140
- March 19, 2012 – AVEOS Fleet Performance files for bankruptcy
- May 2012 – Keewatin Air workers join IAM DL 140
- 2013 – IAM wins \$55 million award for former Air Canada members at AVEOS
- August 2014 – Wasaya Air flight attendants join IAM DL 140
- January 2016 – Edmonton Swissport workers join DL 140
- June 2016 – Toronto Airport Security Screeners join DL 140
- March 7, 2018 – Montreal Swissport ground crew join IAM DL140
- March 29, 2018 – Edmonton ATS workers join IAM DL 140
- April 17, 2018 – Toronto AAS workers join IAM DL 140
- May 3, 2018 – Montreal Swissport cabin groomers join IAM DL 140
- May 23, 2018 – Toronto Carillion workers join IAM DL 140
